  - help you negotiate with a landlord, employer, creditor or agency worker; or
  - represent you in court or at administrative hearings.

### Am I Eligible for Services?

- You qualify for our services if you live in:
- Blaine, Buchanan, Carroll, Dickenson, Floyd, Giles, Grayson, Lee, Montgomery, Pulaski, Russell, Scott, Smyth, Tazewell, Washington, Wise or Wythe Counties
  - OR
  - the cities of Bristol, Galax, Norton or Radford.
- AND
- if your income is as low as our sliding scale permits.

### What Does it Cost?

We do not charge for our services. There may be court costs or other expenses that you might have to pay, but these costs are usually low. We will advise you of any costs involved in your case.

### What If I Am Unable to Come to the Legal Aid Office?

Our offices are accessible to persons in a wheelchair. Our staff will travel to meet you if you are homebound, disabled, or otherwise unable to come to us.

### What Kind of Problems Can Legal Aid Help Me With?

Here are some examples of the kinds of problems that Legal Aid might be able to help you with:

#### FAMILY

- need protection from an abusive family member?
- accused of abusing or neglecting your child?
- told your child may be placed in foster care?
- need advice on custody or visitation?

#### CONSUMER

- wages being garnished?
  - told your mobile home or car may be repossessed?
  - threatened with foreclosure?
  - sued for debts you can't afford to pay?
- Financial counseling may also be available free of charge through Legal Aid's Fresh Start Initiative, supported in part by United Way of Southwest Virginia.*

#### LANDLORD/TENANT OR OTHER HOUSING ISSUES

- having trouble making your house payments?
- being evicted or locked out?
- landlord refusing to make repairs?
- can't get into public or subsidized housing?
- refused public or subsidized housing because you are handicapped?
