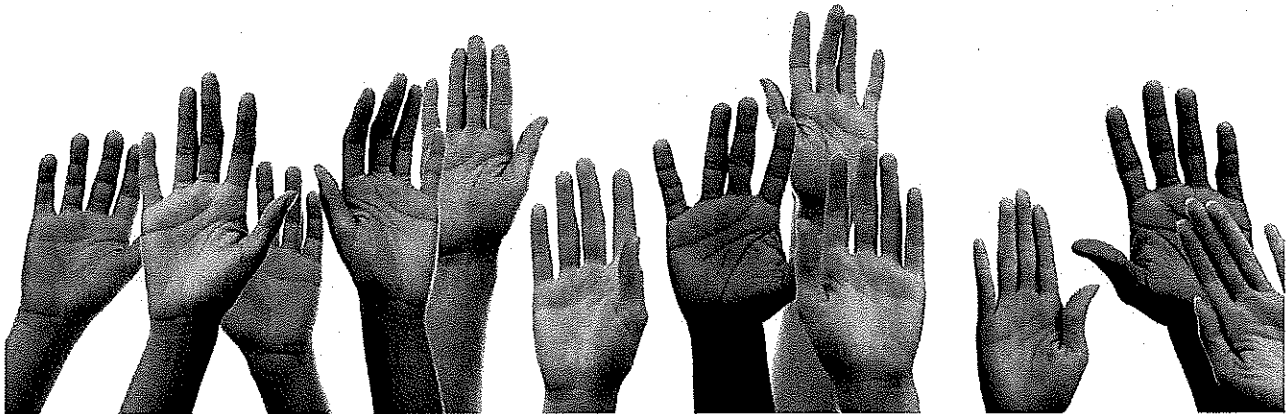

Literacy Volunteers of the New River Valley (LVNRV) provides free and confidential tutoring to adults in the New River Valley, including the counties of Floyd, Giles, Montgomery, Pulaski and the City of Radford. LVNRV helps learners achieve their literacy goals and strengthen their skills for personal independence and better employment.

Learner Centered

Our students play an active role in planning their own learning. Tutors provide instruction that is tailored to the student's goals, learning style and pace of learning. LVNRV cooperates with local libraries, educational institutions and community organizations to provide convenient tutoring locations in each locality.

Volunteer Driven

The power of LVNRV comes from our volunteer tutors. These trained, dedicated tutors help adult students achieve their literacy goals in a safe, confidential setting. Whether they are teaching a student to read, to strengthen workplace skills, or to prepare for citizenship, LVNRV tutors have a powerful and enduring impact on the lives of the students they serve.
