For Your Breast and Cervical Health

Every Woman's Life (EWL) is a public health program providing access to FREE breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services for low income and uninsured women. Early detection of breast and cervical cancer may save your life.

- Screening services (mammogram and/or Pap test) for women ages 40-64.
- Diagnostic services are provided to symptomatic women ages 18-39.

Are you eligible for Every Woman's Life?

To be eligible, you must meet ALL of the following:

- 18 to 64 years old
- Resident of Virginia
- Have no health insurance, OR cannot afford to pay your insurance deductible, OR your insurance does not cover screening exams
- Meet income requirements
